PURPOSE AND RULES OF CONDUCT

PURPOSE

The purpose of Asher Student Foundation is to serve the cause of Christian Science by providing housing for students who are Christian Scientists primarily in one of our seven Asher Houses. Located in seven cities around the country, Asher Houses are welcoming, supportive communities of practicing Christian Scientists who are pursuing individual spiritual as well as educational and/or career development goals.

RULES OF CONDUCT

1. Live in accordance with the teachings of Christian Science.
2. Abstain from the use of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, profanity, gambling, premarital sex or cohabitation.
3. Work and live harmoniously with fellow residents, using the Golden Rule as a guide.
4. Adhere to the spirit of the Matthew Code (Matt 18:15-17): speak directly to the person about a problem and ask for help or support from the House Manager if there is no response or if the matter potentially involves harassment or discrimination. The goal is healing and reconciliation.
5. Never harass or discriminate against any other resident or ASF personnel and report immediately to the House Manager any incident of harassment or discrimination which you witness or learn of.
6. Use the internet, whether using the WiFi provided or not, in a manner that reflects the moral principles of Christian Science, which includes not accessing, downloading or forwarding pornographic material, not downloading, disseminating or forwarding violent, sexist, racist, abusive, or other inappropriate messages or media.
7. Support and participate in Asher activities.
8. Support the House Manager in maintaining the operation and spiritual atmosphere of the house.
9. Attend and support the activities of the local Christian Science branch church and CSO on a regular basis.
